



## RoHS Declaration

IPP Operations, LLC (IPP) is committed to providing products which are safe with respect to the environment and human health. In that regard, IPP takes note of the European Union Restriction on Hazardous Substances (EU RoHS directives) Directive 2011/65/EU, including amendment EU 2015/863, Directive (EU) 2025/2456, and the People's Republic of China requirements for concentration limits of certain hazardous substances in Electronic Information Products RoHS – Standard SJ/T 11363-2006, Classification EIP-A, which collectively prohibit the following substances in amounts above specified thresholds in electrical and electronic equipment.
